Source water from Silver Springs Water is from Padre Dam Municipal Water District. The source water from Padre Dam is within all Federal and State regulations.

Silver Springs Water meets all bottled water regulations and contaminate levels allowed by law. The water purification level is maintained at a level of 3 parts per million, well below the allowed amounts regulated by the FDA and The California Health Dept. Silver Springs Water goal is to provide the public with another option level of purification beyond the municipal source.

Silver Springs Water purification process consist of carbon filter system as the first step to a water softener system, to a 5 micron pre filter, to the eight stage reverse osmosis process. Once called from the holding tanks the purified water is processed through the Ozone contact tank.

Silver Springs Water bottles are inspected before entering an eight stage sterilization process and bottle ozone bottle rinse. After a purified water final rinse. The Silver Springs Water bottle is then filled with our treated and processed water. The bottle is then capped with another ozone sprayed cap. The bottle is then date coded and is ready for final inspection. Once the bottles are hand loaded on a bottle rack, they are then forked lifted on the delivery truck and ready for delivery.

In the unlikely event of a recall Silver Springs Water follows the FDA recall process as outlined at FDA.gov
